## Covid-19 Bar/Bat Mitzvah Policy

We re very much looking forward to celebrating with you and your family and loved ones for your children's b'nai mitzvah. In addition to the other requirements for entering the building (all have to wear masks, no singing, submit to temperature check and fill out a questionnaire affirming that they are, to their knowledge, not infected, etc.)

- 1. We are capping the number of attendees at 40 as a hard number.
- 2. We now have plexiglass barriers on the bimah for added safety.
- 3. While you may have a sit-down lunch following, our food policy guidelines (available at bethemethde.org), no kiddush/oneg is permitted, in order to maximize social distancing.
- 4. We are requiring that all attendees family, friends, etc. sign the waiver (also available at bethemethde.org).
- 5. We are also requiring that you provide the names, phone numbers and addresses of any quests, so that if we find out that an attendee was infected but asymptomatic we can provide that list for contact tracing purposes.
